
What is our sustainability framework?

Sustainability means an organization or program already does and is positioned to create long lasting and relevant social impact.



What are the six key drivers of sustainability?

- Social Impact: Results of efforts taken that solve or positively advance social issues by producing a positive change in attitude, behavior or condition for the target constituency
- Focused Business Strategy: Understanding of what has to happen to achieve social goals and choices about how to accomplish those goals
- Economic Viability: Financial health of an alliance; sustainable efforts have a surplus or breakeven operating model that will carry the work forward in the long-term

What are the six key drivers of sustainability?

- Capacity to Deliver: Talent, infrastructure and processes needed to execute the business strategy in order to deliver social impact
- Adaptability: The discipline of updating and/or developing products and services in anticipation or response to changes in beneficiary needs, behaviors and the operating environment
- Partnership Building and Stakeholder Engagement: The ongoing cultivation and engagement of a cohort of well-functioning, diverse partners and stakeholders who collaborate and communicate effectively to advance the efforts of the alliance
